**VERMONT-BASED EXPERTS ADVISE NATION'S TRANSPORTATION AGENCIES
Vermont Firm Wins 5-Year Contract to Help Federal Government
Tackle State and Local Transportation Challenges**

(Resource Systems Group, Inc., White River Junction, VT)—The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has awarded Resource Systems Group, Inc. (RSG) a five-year prime contract to provide technical expertise and support in eight transportation-related task areas, including congestion management, travel demand forecasting, safety planning, freight analysis, and metropolitan, statewide and rural planning. This federal "*Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ)*" task order contract is potentially worth \$10 million over the lifetime of the award. This is RSG's second consecutive award for similar services from FHWA.
